## TOURNAMENT PLAY/FORMAT HILL COURSE GUIDELINES

## Format: 4-PLAYER SCRAMBLE

Before play starts choose a Team Captain. The Captain is responsible for his/her team's player etiquette and behavior on the Course. On every hole, each member of the team may hit a tee shot. The Team Captain then selects one of the shots from which to play. All members of the team may then hit from that position. This procedure is repeated until the ball is holed or the team reaches the max score. We suggest Bogey which is 1 (one) stroke over par. That means if the teams Par attempt is not holed out then you move on to the next tee box (to clear the green) and record a BOGEY for the competed hole.

During a Scramble each team member may place his/her ball within one club length, of the selected shot, no nearer to the hole. If the shot selected is played from a hazard, bunker, rough, fairway or fringe of the green, it must remain in the hazard, bunker, rough, fairway, or fringe of the green. When putting, the ball must be placed within six (6) inches from the mark, no closer to the hole.

Note: AGAIN, please pick up your golf balls once you have reached the maximum score for the hole and move to the next Tee Box to record that score. *This action really adds up and contributes to great Pace of Play for your Tournament.* 

Tees:

Men – White Senior Men (over 60) - Gold Women – Red

## **Special Events:**

#9 - Longest Drive - Women #10-Longest Drive - Men#18 - Closest to the Pin - Women #4-Closeset to the Pin - Men

<u>NOTE:</u> Please keep your carts on the cart path around all Tee Boxes and Greens. <u>Carts must always remain 30' from Tee Boxes and Greens!</u>

REPLACE ALL DIVOTS - REPAIR BALL MARKS ON THE GREENS - RAKE SAND TRAPS - FOLLOW CART RULES

## Captain's Responsibility: Posting all scores via Moose Run App. See separate e-scoring Instruction Sheet.

Contest Hole markers: Must be picked up by the Last Team & Turned in at Registration or Pavilion Scoring Table Immediately upon completing play!
